Dog Park Rules

Open 6:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Monday-Tuesday and Thursday-Sunday

Open 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Wednesday*

***Closed second Wednesday of each month for maintenance**

For Your Safety and Enjoyment

- Dogs must be leashed before entering and upon leaving the park (IMC 4-5-701)
- Owner/Guardian is liable for damage or injury inflicted by their dog(s). Owner/Guardian is legally and financially responsible for their dog's behavior (IMC 4-5-703)
- Dogs must be properly licensed and vaccinated with registration and rabies tags displayed on the dog's collar (IMC 4-5-201, 4-5-203, 4-5-301)
- Every dog must wear a collar or harness at all times
- Please clean up and properly dispose of any waste (IMC 3-4-105.B)
- Owner/Guardian must be in verbal and sight control of their dogs at all times
- Owner/Guardian must prevent aggressive behavior, including biting, fighting and barking
- Children ages 13 and younger must be accompanied by an adult
- Only persons with dogs are permitted within the park
- No more than three dogs per owner/guardian
- Please report any hazards or damage immediately

Prohibited Activities

- Aggressive dogs and/or dogs with a known history of dangerous behavior
- Leaving a dog unattended for any amount of time
- Puppies younger than 4 months
- Choke, prong (pinch) and spiked dog collars
- Sick or injured dogs
- Female dogs in heat and/or lactating
- Animals other than dogs
- No food (human or dog) of any kind
- Motor vehicles, bicycles or scooters (IMC 3-4-108, 3-4-110)
- Smoking or glass containers (IMC 3-4-134, 3-4-137)
- Formal events of any kind shall not be held without prior written approval by the City of Irvine (IMC 3-4-123, 3-4-127, 3-4-129, 3-4-301)
- Graffiti or other means of defacing City property (IMC 3-4-126, 4-11-405)
- Alcohol (IMC 3-4-133)
- Professional dog trainers/handlers using the facility for instruction
- Using this facility if hazardous conditions exist
- Using the park for any other use (i.e. playing catch between two or more people, climbing trees, tag games)
- Large breed dogs within the small dog park. Small breed dogs within the large dog park
