Winter holidays are a time of sharing. A time we celebrate moving from darkness to the light. A time when great joy is found in giving. The Irvine Animal Care Center needs your help to shine brightly for animals in need, to share the gifts of kindness, comfort, and care with them, and to be the salvation they seek. In the past year, two-thirds of the stray pets we took in went unclaimed by their owner. We've seen the number of owner-surrendered pets grow by 65% since a 2021–2022 low. Your donation will provide crucial funding for victims of animal cruelty, neglect, and pets whose owners desperately need support. Your donation illuminates a bleak future and creates the path to a forever home. Funding for the center's Enhanced Care, Foster Care, and Third Chance for Pets programs made a life-saving difference for these pets and many more.

Aldo: Found stray, unable to walk, with multiple wounds to his face and chest. Enhanced Care surgery was required to treat his injuries, including repairing a broken femur using a titanium plate and screws. Foster Care volunteers nurtured him back to health, and began the work of teaching this shy boy that it was safe to trust. With time, both his body and heart were able to mend, and Aldo found his forever home.

Sadie: Abandoned, with severe dental disease, anemia, and a gigantic hernia mass. Staff made plans for immediate hernia surgery and followed up with dental surgery when Sadie was strong enough to undergo the second Enhanced Care procedure. Sadie's Foster Care family Fell All In Love (FAILed), and Sadie was adopted through the center's Seniors for Seniors program.



Spring: An 8-week-old kitten was found stray overnight and rushed to an emergency hospital. It eventually took two nerve-wracking Enhanced Care surgeries to save Spring from the degloving damage to her paw, chin, head, and spine. Degloving is severe and traumatic. Spring's bandages were almost as big as she was! Donations made the difference for Spring, who is now flourishing with her forever family.

Mira: Brought to the center with a leg fracture and severed ear. Surgical intervention

reated both. Mira recovered in Foster Care. Soon after her return, Mira was adopted! Kaldi: Blind stray brought

in by a driver who accidentally hit her. Enhanced Care surgery reconstructed her leg, avoiding amputation.

Foster Care volunteer provided special accommodation during recovery. Kaldi was adopted into a happy home!

Prancer: At just

2-years-old required hip surgery and oral surgery to become adoptable,

then adopted he was!
