# ITEM 1.2 ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

#### Irvine Child Care Project (ICCP) Administrator's Report November 18, 2024

#### Scholarships/Grants to Fund Scholarships:

- ICCP Scholarship applications for 2024-25 are being accepted. As of October 23, 2024, 65 applications have been received; 27 scholarships have been awarded; 36 applications did not meet eligibility requirements (or application was withdrawn); 2 are in process.
- Please note: In order to be eligible for a ICCP Scholarship, all adults within the household must be employed full-time for students in grades 1 through 6.
  - As of October 16, 2024 the Irvine Children's Fund approved an exception for students in Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten since these grades are offered on a part time schedule through Irvine Unified School District, therefore adults in the household may be working part time and still be eligible for funding.
    - This change in eligibility criteria resulted in four Pre-Kindergarten/Kindergarten children to be awarded an ICCP Scholarship who otherwise would not have been eligible.
- Children's Home Society of California offers subsidized child care programs to assist income eligible families with all or part of their child care expenses. The application is available online at *cityofirvine.org/child-care-development*.

#### Program Quality:

- Quality assessments are conducted on an on-going basis at ICCP sites throughout the school year. Recommendations for 2025-26 lease renewals will be made to the ICCP Board in May 2025 and will be based on continued compliance with State of California Community Care Licensing Requirements and ICCP Quality Assessment Standards.
- The City continues to provide a curated list of upcoming professional development events on the online Training Calendar, and links to On-Demand Training and Resources, on the City's Child Care & Development website.
