

CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 24-94

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, APRIL 15, 2025, FOR THE ELECTION OF A COUNCILMEMBER REPRESENTING COUNCIL DISTRICT 5 TO FILL A VACANCY AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE CITY CHARTER

WHEREAS, a vacancy in the office of Councilmember representing Council District 5 was created by the election of Councilmember Larry Agran to the office of Mayor on December 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the term of office in which the vacancy occurs for Council District 5 ends on December 8, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the City Charter, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Irvine, California, on Tuesday, April 15, 2025, a Special Municipal Election for the purpose of the election of a Councilmember representing District 5 for the term of office in which the vacancy was created by the election of Councilmember Larry Agran to the office of Mayor which ends on December 8, 2026.

SECTION 2. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 3. That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 4. That the polls/vote centers shall be located at Irvine City Hall, 1 Civic Center Plaza, Irvine, California; and University Park Community Center, 1 Beech Tree Lane, Irvine, California.

SECTION 5. That the polls/vote center at Irvine City Hall shall be operational between April 5, 2025, through April 11, 2025, at eight o'clock a.m. and shall remain open continuously from that time until five o'clock p.m., and April 12, 2025, through April 14, 2025, at eight o'clock a.m. and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. pursuant to California Elections Code § 4003(b).

SECTION 6. That the polls/vote center at University Park Community Center shall be operational between April 12, 2025, through April 14, 2025, at eight o'clock a.m. and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight p.m. pursuant to California Elections Code § 4003(d).

SECTION 7. That the polls/vote centers at Irvine City Hall and University Park Community Center shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the day of the election, April 15, 2025, and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls/vote centers shall be closed, pursuant to Election Code § 10242, except as provided in except as provided in §§14212, 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 8. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 9. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 10. That pursuant to the requirements of §10002 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Orange is hereby requested to consent and agree to permit the Orange County Registrar of Voters to render specific services to the City of Irvine relating to the conduct of the Special Municipal Election; and further, pursuant to Elections Code §10002, the City of Irvine is hereby authorized to reimburse the County of Orange for the actual cost incurred in conducting the election upon receipt of a bill stating the amount due as determined by the elections official.

SECTION 11. That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to coordinate with the Orange County Registrar of Voters to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 12. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
