FOR CERTAIN OFFICER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Municipal Election will be held in the City of Irvine on Tuesday, April 15, 2025, for the election of the following officer:

One (1) Member of the City Council – District 5  
Short term (through December 8, 2026)

The nomination period for this office begins on Monday, December 23, 2024, and closes at 5 p.m. on Friday, January 17, 2025. Nomination papers are only available from the City Clerk during regular office hours by appointment only (Monday through Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.). The City Clerk's Office is located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of City Hall, 1 Civic Center Plaza, Irvine, CA, 92606. California Elections Code § 10225 allows for the extension of the nomination period by five (5) calendar days to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbent on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election for that incumbent's elective office *if* the incumbent has not filed by the close of business on the 88<sup>th</sup> day. However, this extension is *not* applicable as there is no incumbent officer eligible to be elected for Council District 5, and therefore, the nomination period will not be extended to Wednesday, January 22, 2025.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

The polls/vote centers will be open between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Tuesday, April 15, 2025.
