Irvine Child Care Project (ICCP) Administrator's Report

February 10, 2025

Scholarships/Grants to Fund Scholarships:

• ICCP Scholarship applications for 2024-25 are being accepted. As of December 31, 2024, 24 children have been served with 1,556 child days of enrollment.

Program Quality:

- As of January 31, 21 Comprehensive Quality assessments have been conducted at ICCP sites for the 2024-25 school year. Additionally, all 29 planned consolidated visits have taken place. Recommendations for 2025-26 lease renewals will be made to the ICCP Board in May 2025 and will be based on continued compliance with State of California Community Care Licensing Requirements and ICCP Quality Assessment Standards.
- The quarterly Director's Forum was held on February 6, 2025 at Irvine City Hall.
 The forum featured a presentation on effectively working with outside agencies who
 provide 1:1 aides to support children having special needs while attending an afterschool care program.

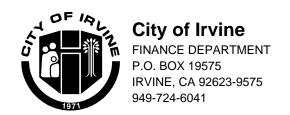
