Your Guide to Irvine's Special Municipal Election

The City of Irvine is holding a Special Municipal Election Tuesday, April 15, for a Councilmember to represent Council District 5.

Why is a Special Municipal Election being held?

In December 2024, the City Council called for the Special Municipal Election to fill a vacancy created in the November 2024 election.

The successful candidate will serve through the end of 2026.

Who can vote in this election?

All registered voters in Council District 5 can vote for a Councilmember to represent their district.

All eligible residents in Council District 5 who are not registered to vote are encouraged to register by March 31. Registration can be completed online at ocvote.gov or by mail. Voter registration forms are available at the Irvine Civic Center, in local libraries and post offices, and City of Irvine community centers.

How do I know if I live in Council District 5?

Visit the City's voting district dashboard available at cityofirvine.org/yourdistrict to determine what district you live in and discover key features and facilities within it.

Where and how can I vote?

All registered voters will receive a combined voter information guide and a vote-by-mail ballot beginning the week of March 17. Ballots can be mailed or dropped off at one of two Ballot Drop Boxes once they receive their ballot. Voters can also cast their ballots at one of two Vote Centers.

Where are the Ballot Drop Boxes located?

Two ballot drop boxes will be available at:

- Rancho Senior Center, 3 Ethel Coplen Way
- University Park Library, 4512 Sandburg Way

Where can I find a Vote Center?

There will be two Vote Centers open for this special election. A Vote Center will be available at Irvine City Hall, 1 Civic Center Plaza, beginning April 5, with a second Vote Center opening April 12 at University Community Center, 1 Beech Tree.

Vote Center Hours are:

- April 5–11: 8 a.m.–5 p.m. (*Irvine City Hall only*)
- April 12–14: 8 a.m.–8 p.m. (*both locations*)
- April 15: 7 a.m.–8 p.m. (*both locations*)
