Transition Plan Key Dates

Through March 31

Orange County Public Libraries (OCPL) will operate Heritage Park and University Park Libraries at current service levels.

Katie Wheeler operations will remain the same.

April 1–May 15

OCPL will operate Heritage Park and University Park Libraries at reduced service levels.

Katie Wheeler operations will remain the same.

May 16–June 30

Heritage Park and University Park Libraries will be closed to finalize the transition.

Katie Wheeler operations will remain the same.

July 1

Heritage Park and University Park Libraries will transition as the first branches of a new City-run Irvine Public Library System.

Katie Wheeler will be closed. The City will take over lease and facility operations starting January 1, 2026.
