#### Irvine Child Care Project (ICCP) Administrator's Report March 10, 2025

#### Scholarships/Grants to Fund Scholarships:

- ICCP Scholarship applications for Fiscal Year 2024-25 are being accepted. As of January 31, 2025, 24 children have been served with 1,930 child days of enrollment.
- The Irvine Children's Fund Board has approved a scholarship increase for all families receiving 50% scholarship to 75% scholarship assistance for child care at ICCP Sites tuition effective February 1 through the end of the fiscal year.

#### Program Quality:

• As of February 28, 26 Comprehensive Quality assessments have been conducted at ICCP sites for the 2024-25 school year. Recommendations for 2025-26 fiscal year lease renewals will be made to the ICCP Board in May 2025 and will be based on continued compliance with State of California Community Care Licensing Requirements and ICCP Quality Assessment Standards.

#### **IRVINE CHILD CARE PROJECT**

#### TOPIC: DETERMINATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 GENERAL CHILD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT GRANT ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

**DESCRIPTION:** For over 20 years, the State of California (State) has awarded funds to the Irvine Child Care Project (ICCP) through the General Child Care and Development Program (CCTR). Historically, Catalyst Family Inc. (Catalyst Kids) has served as ICCP subcontractor for subsidized child care services.

The State's Funding Terms and Conditions for CCTR allows contractors to claim administrative costs related to early learning and care programs administration. Administrative costs are calculated as a percentage of the amount earned through monthly enrollment.

Reimbursement of administrative costs are not to exceed 15% of the net reimbursable program costs, or actual administrative costs, whichever is less.

In Fiscal Year 2024-25, 98% of reimbursable program costs were issued to Catalyst Kids. ICCP retained the remaining 2% as an administrative fee. ICCP reimburses the City for grant administration with these funds. Administrative fees have remained unchanged since 2008.

In order to prepare the Fiscal Year 2025-26 CCTR subcontract agreement with Catalyst Kids, administrative fees must be determined.

With increased child care costs related to the COVID-19 pandemic incurred by Catalyst Kids, and the healthy reserve maintained by ICCP, it is recommended the CCTR administrative fee remain at 2% for Fiscal Year 2025-26 contract.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve a 2% administrative fee for the General Child Care and Development Program for inclusion in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 contract with Catalyst Family Inc.

#### **IRVINE CHILD CARE PROJECT**

#### TOPIC: DETERMINATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 CHILD CARE PROVIDER RENTAL RATE

**DESCRIPTION:** Traditionally, the Irvine Child Care Project Board (Board) has approved an annual 3% rent increase for ICCP providers as part of the budget development process. No rent increase was included in the approved budgets for Fiscal Year (FY) 2009-10 through FY 2011-12 due to the economic climate and declining enrollment at some ICCP sites. A rent increase was approved for fiscal years 2012-13 through 2018-19. No rent increase was included in the approved budgets for fiscal years 2019-20 through 2024-25.

Following the Board's decision, lease agreements will be prepared and mailed to child care providers for signature. New leases will take effect July 1, 2025.

- **RECOMMENDATION:** Approve one of the following rental rate options for FY 2025-26:
  - Option 1: 1% Increase
  - Option 2: 2% Increase
