Making Travel to School Safer in Irvine

- The City of Irvine, Irvine Unified School District (IUSD), and Tustin Unified School District (TUSD) are working together to develop pedestrian and bicycle safety action plans to encourage safer and active travel to school.

What is Suggested Routes to School (SRTS)?

- Suggested Routes to School (SRTS) focuses on how to make walking, bicycling, and rolling easier and safer for students. The recommendations on neighborhood streets benefit us all!

What will the SRTS Project Include?

- 45 maps and a set of prioritized projects for each public school in the City.
- Each SRTS assessment will be tailored to individual schools, showing the locations of nearby bicycle facilities and traffic control devices, such as traffic signals and stop signs.
- It will also include specific recommendations for improvements.
