- Assist with the development of various recreation and drop-in programs, camps, classes, and special events for residents of all ages, interests, and cultural backgrounds.
- Provide after-school transportation from area schools to park sites. Training for operating City vans will be provided.
- Assist in supervising facility operations and reservations including scheduling, record-keeping, room set-ups, walk-throughs, and customer service. Maintain facilities and equipment.
- Assist with hiring, training, scheduling, and evaluating part-time staff and volunteers. Coordinate daily program responsibilities and projects. Provide support to the Leaders in Training volunteer program.
- Provide staff and customer support by using CivicRec reports, including preparing class rosters and daily participant check-ins.
- Assist with program marketing materials, reports, and statistical data.
- Shifts are typically scheduled weekdays 8 a.m.-6 p.m., evenings, and weekends.

Minimum Qualifications:

Two years college or university level work in Recreation, Early Childhood Education, Human Services, Social Ecology, or related field, and two years of experience as a Community Services Leader, or any combination of education and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities.

- Experience planning and implementing child services, recreation classes, and special events.
- Exceptional communication and decision-making skills to create positive relationships with program participants, school personnel, staff, contract instructors, and community members.
