

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

JEFFREY OPEN SPACE TRAIL I-5 BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE PROJECT

Project Information

Construction of the Jeffrey Open Space Trail (JOST) I-5 Bicycle and Pedestrian Bridge, a Class 1 Bridge which will connect the JOST/Cypress Village Trail to the north and the JOST extension to the south, is underway.

Continuing the next phase of work, falsework steel beams and plywood forms will be removed over and across the I-5 Freeway, which requires multiple nighttime lane closures and full freeway closures during the next few weeks.

The entire project is anticipated to be complete in March 2026.

Lane and Freeway Closures

All work will be done nightly from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Week of Monday, September 8

- Monday, September 8 and Tuesday, September 9:
 Northbound and southbound I-5 Freeway lane closures.
- Wednesday, September 10, and Thursday, September 11:
 Southbound Jeffrey off-ramp and southbound I-5 Freeway lanes closures.
- Friday, September 12, and Saturday, September 13:
 Southbound I-5 Freeway full closure from Culver Drive to Jeffrey Road.

Week of Monday, September 15

- Monday, September 15, through Thursday, September 18: Northbound I-5 Freeway lane closures.
- Friday, September 19, and Saturday, September 20:
 Northbound I-5 Freeway full closure from SR-133 to
 Jeffrey Road and southbound I-5 Freeway lane closures.

Week of Monday, September 22

 Monday, September 22, through Friday, September 26: Northbound I-5 Freeway Jeffrey Road off-ramp and Sand Canyon Avenue off-ramp closures. Southbound SR-133 to northbound I-5 Freeway connector closure.

Access

There will be limited or no access to I-5 Freeway, or on-ramps at Culver Drive and Jeffrey Road and connectors during the times listed above. Detour signage will be in place to direct motorists. Detour signage will be in place to direct motorists.

What to Expect

The work will generate normal construction noise including equipment backup alarms and heavy equipment engines, and additional lighting may be required.

Subsequent notifications will be provided as the project progresses.
