- Assist in supervising facility operations and reservations including scheduling, record-keeping, room set-ups, walk-throughs, and customer service. Maintain facilities and equipment.
- Act as the liaison for facility reservations including maintenance of contracts and forms.
- Provide staff and customer support by using CivicRec reports, including registering participants, preparing class rosters, batching payments, and preparing deposits.
- Monitor and evaluate classes including enrollment, activities, changes, and associated details.
- Process and account for contract instructor payments; complete logs and records pertinent to operations.
- Assist with hiring, training, scheduling, and evaluating part-time staff and volunteers. Coordinate daily program responsibilities and projects.
- Develop and maintain positive working relationships with staff, program participants, school personnel, contract instructors, sports officials, and community members.
- Assist with the development and maintenance of program marketing materials and resources. Research, prepare, and disseminate necessary reports, publicity, and statistical data.
- Support and lead youth recreation programs as needed.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Two years college or university level work in Recreation, Kinesiology, or related field, and two years of experience as a Community Services Leader, or any combination of education and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities.
- Ability to push, pull, lift, or carry equipment/supplies (weighing up to 50 lbs.), and lean, stoop, twist, and bend in the performance of job duties.
