As the federal government shutdown continues, funding for CalFresh/SNAP benefits is uncertain. Food banks and local food pantries are feeling the strain, with a 492% increase in calls for help.

The City of Irvine is teaming up with the Greater Irvine Chamber of Commerce, OC Hunger Alliance, South County Outreach, and many Irvine businesses for a one-day emergency food drive and online fundraising event.

- Pasta (dry)
- Pasta sauce

- Diapers (sizes 3 and up)
- Baby wipes
