## ***Sergio O’Cadiz Moctezuma: In Process***

Over five decades, Sergio O’Cadiz Moctezuma significantly shaped the cultural landscape of Orange County through his work as a studio artist, architect, and muralist. His ability to navigate multiple realms of creative production — from ambitious and innovative approaches to muralism to landscape-defining architectural projects to works on canvas and paper — defies simple categorizing.

O’Cadiz’s unique experience as a Mexican-born artist living and working in Orange County during the 1960s through the 1990s imbues his personal and artistic story with important nuance and complexity resonant today. *Sergio O’Cadiz Moctezuma: In Process* presents a glimpse into the artist’s personal and professional complexity, revealing stories and processes that shaped a pivotal figure in the history of Orange County. The exhibit features artist ephemera, archival sketches of realized and unrealized works, sculptures, and select drawings and paintings.
