Great Park Timelines & City Council Action

- **July 26, 2022:** Great Park Framework Plan Adoption
- **March 14, 2023:** Approved Framework plan phasing and implementation approach
- **September 9, 2025:** Great Park Board Update
- **October 28, 2025:** City Council Resolution
 - "Formally incorporate a Central or Main Library into the Northern Sector of the Great Park Framework Plan, to explore funding sources therefor, and, upon identification of funding sources, to expeditiously build said library"
- **January 27, 2026:** Great Park Board Update, including Library pad construction to begin
April 2026

Additional Comments

BOARD 1 POST-IT NOTES	
1	Teens & Homework help and college prep: "Look at Irvine HS - Heritage Park Library Pipeline: teens use facility as study space A LOT (maybe probably more than adults?) You will see Portola HS (at) GP Library, the HIS effect is real"
2	Group study/collaboration/music practice rooms and Media and technology lab: technology and digital skills: "Both (music practice room + digital tech lab) work well with Library of Things (instruments, cameras, mics, etc.) Maybe a Library of Things corner with all of these?"
3	E-library and digital materials: (2 comments) 1) "Purchase subscription to CANDID / Foundation Center"; 2) "News subscriptions, i.e. NY Times, OC Register" "1 to 3 day free subscription"
4	Dedicated outdoor learn/play space for kids next to the library: "cool but maybe shouldn't come out of library funding? Would rather have programming, space, catalogue than another playground, just outside the library"
5	Exhibition space: "Irvine Exhibition & History & Research"
6	Cooking and nutrition classes and demonstration kitchen: "Irvine Fine Arts Center has a kitchen I believe? + IUSD at Creekside Education Center and most high schools CCTE. Maybe work with them?"
BOARD 2 POST-IT NOTES	
1	General: "Reservable space for book clubs later in the day"
2	Local history collection/special collections: (3 comments) 1) "HISTORY ROOM"; 2) "Irvine Historical Society has copies of almost EVERY daily edition of Irvine World News from 1971 - 200? Just sitting in their back room. Should be made public! Sounds like a perfect place." 3) "Include archival space for Irvine Master Plan documents unique to Irvine."
BOARD 3 POST-IT NOTES	
1	Quiet reading room with comfortable seating: "library could use separation between quiet/not quiet areas. Big complaint I hear is that the library is too loud now."
BOARD 4 POST-IT NOTES	
1	Cafe/coffee shop: "would love to see this at Heritage Park! Other retail/café options at Great Park but none around Heritage Park/University Park."
2	Exhibition space: (2 comments) 1) "imo just expand the Irvine Fine Arts Center or add to cultural terrace . . . not a priority for libraries (also there's already a proposal for the Laguna Museum of Art at Great Park Cultural Terrace or (smth) right?); 2) Irvine caters itself to many different art/tech studios. There should be a branch in supporting the arts by networking with these studios."
3	Auditorium: guest speakers, film screenings, performance, and cultural events: "kind of unrelated to libraries, but maybe instead of building new auditoriums the city could look into using IUSD's more? It has a lot and I don't think they're being constantly used/reserved especially Northwood and Irvine HS. Could look into expanding/using the City/IUSD Joint Facilities Agreement."



Additional Comments

- “. . . cool, but maybe shouldn’t come out of library funding.” (*Children’s outdoor play space*)
- “. . . kind of related to libraries, but . . .” and “ not a priority of libraries. . . .”
- “Speed at which we raise funds will determine viability and speed of realization and best ensure accountability.”
