



# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

## CITYWIDE CONCRETE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

### Project Information

As part of the City's ongoing effort to improve pedestrian access through the City, the Public Works & Sustainability Department in partnership with Pub Construction, Inc., will begin construction of sidewalk, curb ramp, and miscellaneous concrete and ADA ramp improvements as part of the Street Rehabilitation Program. Work will take place on both arterial and local streets throughout the Woodbury neighborhoods.

### Project Timeline

Work began Tuesday, February 3, and will continue through June.

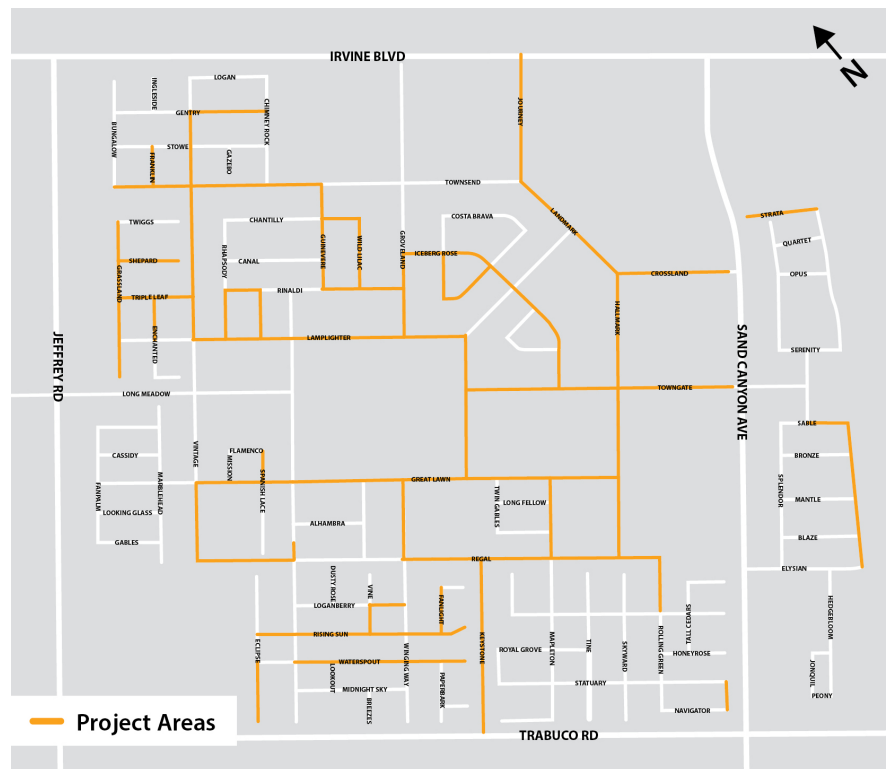
Work will be done Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on residential streets and from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on arterial streets.

### What to Expect

- At least 72 hours before work begins in your area, temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted on streets where work will occur showing the dates and times parking will be restricted. Vehicles parked in violation of a "No Parking" sign will be towed. Parking is allowed on streets without "No Parking" signs.
- Trash services will occur on your normal service day even if work is scheduled.
- Schedules may change to accommodate weather conditions or unforeseen factors. If work does not occur on the posted date, it will be rescheduled and signs with new dates posted 72 hours before work begins.

### Access

Access to streets and driveways may be temporarily restricted while work is underway. If feasible, alternate routes will be provided. Parking within the neighborhood may also be limited during construction activities; vehicles must be parked outside the posted work areas until construction is complete and signage is removed. Access to businesses and private streets or communities will be maintained throughout the project.
