ADDITIONS, DELETIONS, AND REORDERING

Additions to the agenda are limited by California Government Code Section 54954.2 of the Brown Act and for those items that arise after the posting of the Agenda and must be acted upon prior to the next Commission meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENTS - NON-AGENDIZED ITEMS

Any member of the public may address the Commission on items within the Commission's subject matter jurisdiction but which are not listed on this agenda; however, no action may be taken on matters that are not part of the posted agenda. If 20 or fewer requests to provide public comments are submitted, each speaker shall be limited to three minutes. If between 21 and 30 speakers submit public comments, each speaker shall be limited to two minutes. If more than 30 speakers submit public comments, each speaker shall be limited to 90 seconds per item. The time limit per speaker shall be established based on the number of requests to speak submitted to the Recording Secretary before the first speaker is called. Requests to speak submitted after the first speaker is called shall receive 90 seconds. These time limits may be shortened or extended, or a cumulative limit on the time for all public speakers may be imposed, at the discretion of the Chair or by a majority vote of the Commission.

COMMISSION BUSINESS ITEMS

Public comments on Commission Business Items will be heard at the time the matters are considered. If 10 or fewer requests to speak are submitted, each speaker shall be limited to three (3) minutes per item. If between 11 and 15 speakers submit requests to speak, each speaker shall be limited to two (2) minutes per item. If 16 or more requests to speak are submitted, each speaker shall be limited to 90 seconds per item. The time limit per speaker shall be established based on the number of requests to speak submitted to the Recording Secretary before the first speaker is called. Requests to speak submitted after the first speaker is called shall receive 90 seconds. These time limits may be shortened or extended, or a cumulative limit on the time for all public speakers may be imposed, at the discretion of the Chair or by a majority vote of the Commission.

The regular meeting of the Irvine Advisory Commission for Older Adults (Commission) was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on July 16, 2026, in Council Chamber, Irvine Civic Center, 1 Civic Center Plaza, Irvine, California; Chair Wong presiding.

PARTICIPATION IN COMMISSION MEETING

Athena Martinez, Recording Secretary, provided instructions on how to participate in the Commission meeting for those attending via Zoom or in person.

INTRODUCTIONS

There were no introductions.

PRESENTATIONS

1. DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARDS

This award was presented as follows:

- To Debbie Williams for providing over 440 volunteer hours over the past four years in support of the nutrition lunch program.
- To Dreams of America volunteers for providing over 1,640 over the past three years in support of the Nutrition Lunch Program.

2. AFFORDABLE HOUSING UPDATE

Hitta Mosesman, Housing Manager, provided a presentation and responded to Commissioner questions.

Highlights:

- Location waitlists are controlled by each individual private property.
- City is working on a local preference policy and interest list.
- Properties that are federally funded cannot be restricted to Irvine preference.
- Irvine has six existing senior-only housing sites.
- Approximately 1,700 affordable housing units are in development.

Discussion included: various funding sources and requirements; grants/loans available to older adults at risk of losing homes due to maintenance costs and taxes; home share program options; Hoag workforce housing project; county housing vouchers.

3. OLDER ADULT SERVICES UPDATE

Amber Castrey and Hee Jin Lee, Community Services Supervisors, provided a presentation on Strategic Plan for Older Adult Services Year 3 outcomes and responded to Commissioner questions.

Discussion included: space impacts to program expansion; collaboration between City programs.

ANNOUNCEMENTS/REPORTS

Staff Announcements

Supervisor Lee made the following announcements:

- Movies in the Park continue at Hicks Canyon Community Park. Guests can arrive beginning at 6:30 p.m. and movies begin after sunset, weather permitting. "A Minecraft Movie" will be featured on Friday, July 17 and "How to Train Your Dragon" will be featured on Friday, July 24.
- A day trip is planned for August 6 to the historic Del Mar Thoroughbred Club. Participants will depart Lakeview Senior Center at 11:15 a.m., and return at 7 p.m. Cost is \$119 per person, lunch is not provided.
- The Annual Variety Show will be held on August 13 from 12:30 to 3 p.m. at Lakeview Senior Center.

- Comedy Unleashed returns September 15 at Irvine Improv and is a fundraiser in support of the Irvine Animal Care Center. Every ticket purchased supports programs and services that benefit shelter animals while helping them find loving homes. Tickets are \$56 per person.
- A handout summarizing Older Adult Services past events, upcoming programs and services, and participation data from the previous month was provided.

Friends of Outreach (FOO) – Starla Fogerty, President, reported the following:

- FOO is a non-profit fundraising organization in support of Older Adult Services.
- A jewelry fundraiser is planned for July 25 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Lakeview Senior Center.
- Thank you to staff for upgrades to art installations at senior centers.

Irvine Adult Day Health Services, Inc. (IADHS) – Hollis Parmely-Dalton, Executive Director, reported the following:

- Enrolled participants for Fiscal Year 2025-26 was 110 (75 being Irvine residents) with an average daily attendance of 30 (licensed for 60 daily).
- IADHS staff received 278 intake calls resulting in 163 facility tours. Transportation is often cited for enrollment challenges.
- Participant ages range from 53 to 100, and a 100th birthday was celebrated in June.

NEDA-Association of Iranian American Seniors (NEDA) – Nasser Fathi, President, reported the following:

- Weekly socials include dancing, music, Bingo, and other activities and are held each Thursday from 3-5 p.m. at Lakeview Senior Center, averaging 50 participants.
- A monthly evening program is offered the third Thursday of each month from 5-9 p.m. at Lakeview Senior Center and includes live music, dancing, poetry readings.
- Transportation is a challenge for the evening events.
- Thank you to staff for continued support of NEDA's programs and activities.

Orange County Older Adults Advisory Commission – No report.

Nutrition Subcommittee

Commissioner Anderson provided a handout and reported the following from the July 13 meeting:

- Nutrition Program statistics for May were provided.
- Volunteer recruitment is ongoing, with a need for 10 drivers and three servers
- Veterans Day themed lunch will be on November 6.
- Engaging dine-in lunch participants to provide program feedback.
