

# We Made a Mistake...

There is an error on the Sample and Absentee Ballots for the November 2, 2004 election. Instructions **incorrectly** tell voters to “**vote for no more than two (2)**” in the **Irvine City Council** contest.

**CORRECT INSTRUCTIONS: CAST NO MORE THAN THREE (3) VOTES** for the “**Office of Irvine City Council**”

If you are an **Absentee Ballot Voter** it is important to...

1

**Vote the regular Absentee Ballot you received (or will receive) from the Registrar's Office**

- ✓ Vote as instructed on your Absentee Ballot.
- ✓ Your vote for “Office of Irvine Mayor” **will be counted** on this ballot.
- ✓ Your vote for “Office of Irvine City Council” **will not be counted** on this ballot.

**Vote the Supplemental Absentee Ballot you will receive**

- ✓ Vote for **no more than three (3)** candidates for the “Office of Irvine City Council.”
- ✓ This vote **will be counted**.
- ✓ **You will not** be able to vote for the “Office of Irvine Mayor” on this ballot.

**Return your ballots**

- ✓ Ballots **must** be returned **separately** in the envelopes provided by the Registrar's office.
- ✓ Ballots must reach the Registrar by November 2, 8 p.m.

**If You Vote at a Polling Location ...**

Ballot instructions at polling locations will correctly instruct you to cast **no more than three (3)** votes for the “Office of Irvine City Councilmember.”
